



Safeguarding Statement

Pond Meadow is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all children and young people and expect all staff, governors and visitors to actively support this commitment.

Pond Meadow Academy Trust believes that it is unacceptable for any child or vulnerable person to experience abuse and recognises our responsibility to safeguard them.

Staff, governors and visitors are provided with guidance to follow should they suspect a child or young person may be experiencing abuse or be at risk of harm. We work co-operatively with other agencies to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people.

Concerns about pupils are discussed with parents/carers first, unless we have reason to believe that such a move would be contrary to the pupil's welfare.
