




# Make a Rainbow




Can you make a rainbow at home? Here are a few different ways of making one.

Choose your favourite rainbow picture from links below and colour in using pens, crayons or paint. ALD included at the bottom of page



### Fabric Rainbow

Use felt, old material, tissue paper, old wrapping paper, cut up colours from newspaper adverts or magazines and use whatever you have, to make this rainbow collage



### Rainbow Collage

You will need:

- Pva glue
- Cotton buds
- Coloured feathers
- Rainbow colouring sheet with simple rainbow outline (see below)
- Glue stick

Cover the paper with pva glue  
Place the feathers in the rainbow outline.  
Use ALD provided below to choose the colours of feathers. After the rainbow is completed, surround it with cotton buds clouds.



### Paint a Rainbow

You will need:

- Paints
- Brushes
- Plastic beaker
- Long roll of paper, old sheet,

Paint colours onto the tumbler in a rainbow pattern and then roll the painted beaker onto the paper or sheet. Keep reapplying paint and make rainbow patterns.



### **Sensory rainbow fun**

Use rice, porridge oats or pasta if you have any spare to make a rainbow to explore!
