Explore objects, materials, texture tray work with e.g. sand, water, paint, chalks... relating to key stories Operate equipment/computer Role play - simple imaginative play; 3 Bears, 3 Pigs, feeding dolls/teddies, building simple play sequences, incl 'modelled language where appropriate Traditions: Harvest, Divali, Xmas

Physical Development

Experience/explore different ways of moving. Contrast different movement. Stop/start, fast/slow.

Experience / explore simple equipment - mats, steps, tunnels, boxes. PE & sensory circuits. Use of soft play esp steps, climbing.

Use of tools: spades, cups, tubs/pots, scissors, spoons, brushes, pens, chalks.

Small steps getting self undressed/dressed for PE & as opportunity arises. Putting on/taking off wellies.

Communication & Language

PECS & TEACCH work if appropriate

Interaction with adults, including Intensive Interaction, awareness of sounds.

Ready, steady, go games with balloons, balls, hoops, spinning dish, egg chairs...& games in soft play.

Listening games / activities incl 'Attention Bucket' starting 1:1, then 1:2, then in a group. Where appropriate, turn-taking & building skills to work with a peer.

Develop vocabulary to support other areas using objects, photos, symbols, signs, spoken language where appropriate
